Jessica says she went to Israel before Nate. Patty was pregnant when we went there in 1983, so technically Jess is right.



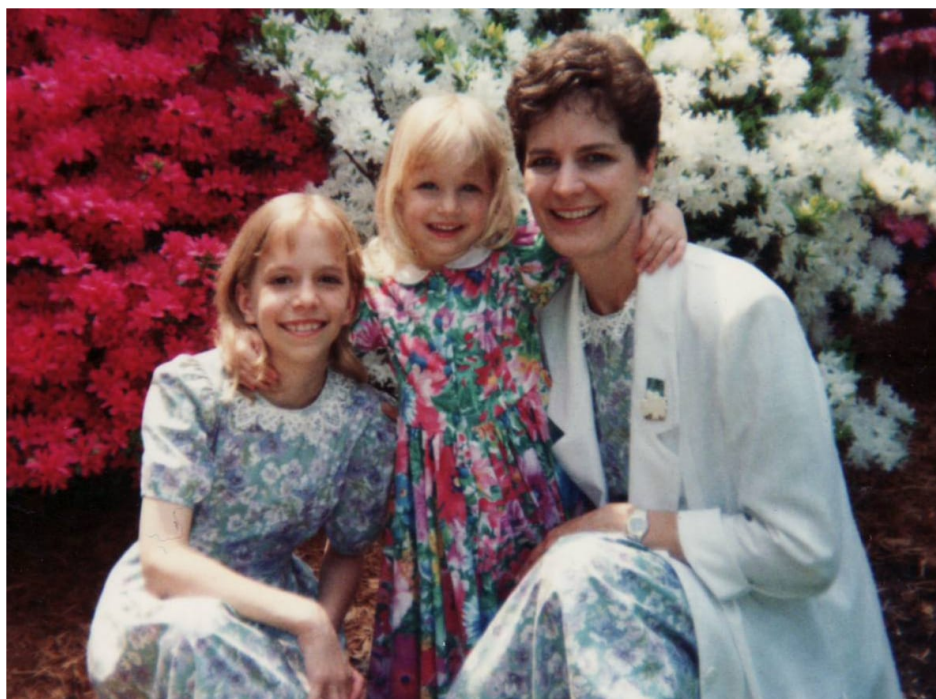
